Notes of pale golden peach, stone fruit, orange peel, Meyer lemon and honey emerge from the 2021 Roero Arneis. It is medium-bodied and salty with fresh

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acidity, citrus pith and a bit of Parmesan. A wonderful aperitif or for crudo, drink it over its next few years of youthful drinking.
