Made with grapes hailing from the townships of Serralunga d'Alba, Castiglione Falletto e Barolo, it's radiant and elegantly structured, delivering flavors of of raspberry, red cherry, star anise and cake spice before closing on wintergreen mint. Taut, refined tannins provide seamless support while fresh acidity keeps it balanced.

Aromas recalling wild rose, red berry, culinary spice, hay and tilled earth come to the forefront on the stunning 2020 Giovanni Rosso Barolo. Showing depth and balance, the savory, elegant palate features crushed raspberry, wild strawberry, ground clove and licorice framed in taut, refined tannins. Fresh acidity keeps it beautifully balanced. Drink 2028–2035.

Bright ruby in color, this is a restrained Barolo with wild strawberry, Parma violet, cinnamon and orange peel aromas. The palate is crisp, with dusty tannins, a medium body, good concentration of blood orange flavors, a tight-knit structure and a polished finish. Approachable now due to the balance, but will improve with time. Drink after 2029.

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weight, beautifully perfumed Barolo is all charm. Bright acids give the 2019 notable verve.

The wine has a bold and upfront nature, open with aromas of candied cherries, medicinal herbs, leather and savory spices. The palate delivers the savory side of the wine, while roasted strawberry and preserved plum play alongside hints of oolong tea. This offers aromas of woodland berry, crushed herb, coffee bean and dog rose. On the lithe palate, chalky tannins accompany Morello cherry, blood orange, espresso and hints of star anise.

A ruby hue, the 2019 Barolo it is highly aromatic, with floral perfume, wild raspberry liqueur, roses and incense. The Giovanni Rosso estate makes some very pretty wines from the Serralunga d'Alba subzone in the Barolo appellation. This classic wine, the 2015 Barolo, provides a good introduction to the distinct taste profile shared by the two single-vineyard wines, Cerretta and Serra, also reviewed here. However, this wine hails from the warm and sunny 2015 vintage and supplies a greater kick of soft cherry fruit and rich concentration when compared to the more streamlined, long-term 2016 vintage. Those dark primary fruit aromas, the acidity and the tannic imprint are all beautifully measured to the enhanced intensity of this pretty and well-priced 2015 Barolo.

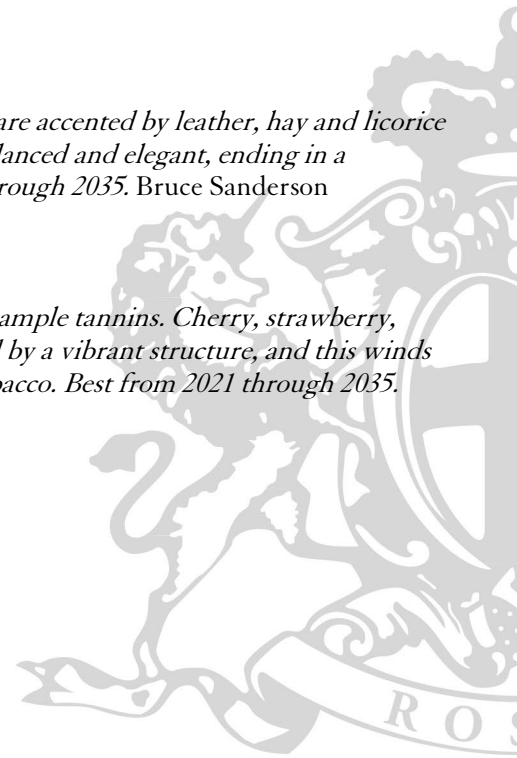
