# ETNA BIANCO

### The Wine Hunter Award **RED**

### Vinous Antonio Galloni 93/100

Widly fresh and focused, the 2023 Etna Bianco wafts up with a lovely blend of peach sorbet, mint leaf and white smoke. This is both juicy and refined, with crisp orchard fruits and hints of candied citrus that enliven the palate. Crisp minerality combines with lime and nectarine; the 2023 finishes long and leaves the mouth watering.

### Kerin O'Keefe 92/100

Spanish broom, stone fruit, hay and citrus aromas form the delicate but enticing nose on the radiant 2023 Etna Bianco from Giovanni Rosso. Bright and tangy, the racy, savory palate features yellow apple, Bartlett pear, Myer lemon and saline notes alongside vibrant acidity. Showing its Etna roots, it has great energy and mineral tension.

### **DECANTER** 91/100

Etna's north slope, or 'versante nord' is better known for its reds, but there are some really impressive Carricantes being made there too. This example from Davide Rosso is whole-bunch pressed then vinified and aged in steel. It has a distinct richness of lees which gives it a soft and round feel in the mouth, while

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the fresh acidity adds tension and energy. Spicy notes mingle with pineapple, tangerine, peach and white flowers.

### **DECANTER**

### 94/100

Fresh and clean on the nose, thick and wide, but with such clarity and juiciness really lovely pink grapefruit, lemon and apple with crushed stone minerality and a touch of spice around the edges. Feels accessible and friendly, almost with a butteriness that gives a slightly thick texture. Round and forward, lots of life to this with gorgeous juicy acidity that really lifts the expression. Great stuff, have chilled with seafood! Ageing in stainless steel tanks for five months on the lees with regular batonnages every week. From 5.5 hectares planted in 1975 in Solicchiata - Montedolce. ## Kerin O'Keefe 92/100

Made mostly with Carricante and a small amount of other local Etna grapes, the lovely 2022 Etna Bianco from Giovanni Rosso opens with delicate aromas of white stone fruit, flint and Mediterranean herb. It's delicious and polished, delivering both ripe apricot, juicy Myer lemon and salty mineral notes while bright acidity lends great tension and freshness. Drink or hold through 2029.

The Giovanni Rosso 2021 Etna Bianco is a lovely wine with the energy and mineral saltiness to underline its volcanic character. The bouquet starts off elegantly with Sicilian aromas of orange blossom and sweet almond, but the wine's final sensations revert to fresh lemon and crushed stone. Its medium concentration and freshness will serve it well as it continues its bottle evolution. Monica Larner

# Wine Enthusiast 93/100

Lightly fragrant and loaded with finesse, this focused white opens with delicate aromas of white spring flower, rosemary, thyme and Mediterranean brush. Smooth and fresh, the palate boasts a weightless, understated elegance that seamlessly offsets ripe yellow pear, juicy Meyer lemon and savory saline notes. Kerin O'Keefe

# Tom Cannavan's Wine Pages 92/100

From a vineyard planted in 1975, this is mainly Carricante with small percentages of other local varieties. Though unoaked, five months sur lie with regular batonnage builds texture and aroma, focused on lemon and crunchy red apples, but with a hint of ozone and of something more ripe and peachy too. Any suggestion of peach is soon blown away on the palate, which streaks with vivid lemon and salts, and although there is very good texture adding mouthfeel and creaminess, its that energising thrust of citrus and salinity that drives the long, focused finish.
