Rose, red berry and citrus aromas mingle with a whiff of eucalyptus on the pretty 2023 Langhe Nebbiolo from Giovanni Rosso. Smooth and savory, the lithe palate is a quintessential expression of youthful Nebbiolo, offering strawberry compote, blood orange and star anise. Polished tannins lend lithe support.

VINTAGE 2021

Smooth and enveloping, the Giovanni Rosso Langhe Nebbiolo is a quintessential example of this designation. Showing the charm of young Nebbiolo, it has lovely aromas of iris, woodland berry and wild herb while the delicious, polished palate doles out crushed strawberry, juicy cherry and star anise. Lithe tannins and fresh acidity keep it balanced.

Falstaff Nebbiolo Trophy 2024

Brilliant dark ruby red. The nose is very ripe, with notes of dark berry fruit, bittersweet chocolate, and a hint of citrus, followed by delicate cherry in the finish. On the palate, it is rich and textured, warm-hearted, with well-integrated tannins, displaying a generous and accessible character even at this stage.

VINTAGE 2018

Decanter

Mostly from Roddino, this is the entry-level wine of the Giovanni Rosso estate, aged in botte grande for just a few months and focused on a fruity style. Bright ruby in the glass, it shines for its freshness of red berries, becoming more intense with a cherry flavour and adding some complexity from a slightly meaty, beefy palate. The tannins are austere and the body is not too concentrated, so this Nebbiolo calls for pairing with food. Drinking Window 2021 – 2028 Aldo Fiordelli

Tom Cannavan's Wine Pages

Ageing is in 5,000-litre casks for this Langhe Nebbiolo. A 2018, the colour is garnet with a little amber on the rim and the nose is firm and fairly ungiving at this stage, some small red fruits, raspberry freshness. It is firm and just a touch lean on the palate at this stage, but beyond that the purity of the fruit is very fine, and the balance and structure of the wine good, plentiful cherry acidity and fine tannins. This could loosen up a little over a year or two in bottle. Tom Cannavan

A soft, pretty red with plum, chocolate and light hazelnut character. Not the biggest wine, but enjoyable and delicate. Drink now.

Aperitif Norway

Clear warm red. Aromatic and soft with nice floral and spice tones, good intense red fruit. Fine acidity and tannins, good freshness and long finish.

VINFORUM

Made from declassified barolo grapes. Fresh, clean and appealing Nebbiolo with hints of cherries, plums, leather and spices on the scent. Nicely full-bodied and rich wine with fine acidity, good length, distinctive tannins and a tight and dry finish. Arne Ronold
